



Welcome to St Mary of the Angels Secondary College PAM (Parent Access Module)

Step 1: Type pam.smotanathalia.catholic.edu.au into your internet web browser OR click on the Parent Access Module on the College's website www.smotanathalia.catholic.edu.au

The screen below will load.



Step 2: The first time you login you will need to enter the Username and Password below.



NB. The username is not case sensitive however the <u>password is case sensitive</u> (the **S** is a capital letter).

Step 3: Click on 'Login'. You should now see your child(ren)'s name on photo on the screen.

Step 4: Please click on the 'My Settings' button in the burgundy banner at the top of the screen.

Enter your email address and confirm your email. Click on save.

(This email address will be used to send your password should you forget).

Please change your password and repeat in the confirm password box. Click on save.

Step 5: Return to child(ren)'s page by clicking on the 'Home' button in the burgundy banner at the top

of the screen.

Step 6: Click on the box with your child's photo and name to find information such as their timetable,

student assessment and reporting or Learning Areas.


PAM (Parent Access Module) will give parents and guardians immediate access to all relevant reports and current information.

STUDENT TIMETABLE:


- You can see your child's timetable for the week
